All alternative, Grad PLUS, and Unsubsidized loans accrue interest from the first disbursement. Students may defer principal and interest payments until the start of the repayment period. None of these lenders charges a financial penalty for pre-payment of these loans.

The fees charged at disbursement are percentages that are taken out of each semester's disbursement. The fees charged at repayment are percentages of the total outstanding balance at the start of repayment.

Interest rates vary from one lending institution to another. It is very important that you read all information on your Master Promissory Note (MPN) before signing it. If you do not understand all information, please call your lender for clarification.

* Credit approvals on Grad PLUS and alternative loans are generally valid for 90 to 180 days, confirm with your lender.
