- **Setting:** Private non-profit university, College of Health Sciences, Public Health Program. The University is a member of the Touro College system, headquartered in New York City, New York.
- **Location:** Touro University California is located on historic Mare Island in the San Pablo Bay, 40 minutes by ferry to downtown San Francisco and just minutes from the Napa/Sonoma Wine Country.
- **Accreditation:** As of October 30, 2009, the MPH Program at Touro University California has received full accreditation from the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH) for a five-year term extending to December 31, 2014. Regional accreditation of Touro University California is provided by the Accrediting Commissions for Senior Colleges and Universities of the West Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).
- **Graduate Degrees:** Master of Public Health (MPH); Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (DO)/MPH Dual Degree).
- **Joint Degree:** Joint Master of Science in Physicians Assistant Studies (MSPAS)/MPH – all applicants must apply via the Central Application Service for Physicians Assistants (CASPA); see the Joint MSPAS/MPH Program website for details.
- **Tracks (Concentrations):** Community Health & Global Health.
- **Number of Units Required:** 42
- **Certificate Programs:** Community Health Education Specialist (CHES) Preparation Certificate - 25 units required; Graduate Certificate in Public Health (GCPH) – 16 units required.
- **Enrollment:** 258 total - MPH - 94; DO/MPH - 51; Joint MSPAS/MPH - 111; GCPH - 2
- **Application deadlines:** Fall – July 15 and Summer – April 15.
- **Application fee:** \$50.00 (fee waived for dual degree applicants).
- **Calendar:** The Program's academic calendar is divided into semester sessions - from August to December (Fall), January to May (Spring), and June to August (Summer). In keeping with its founding traditions and values, Touro University California observes the Jewish calendar.

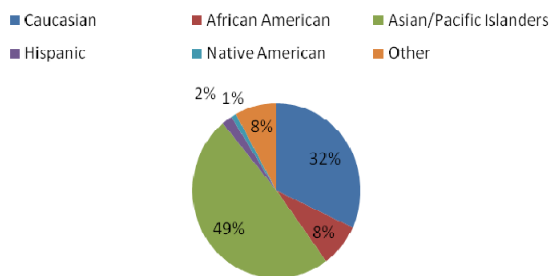

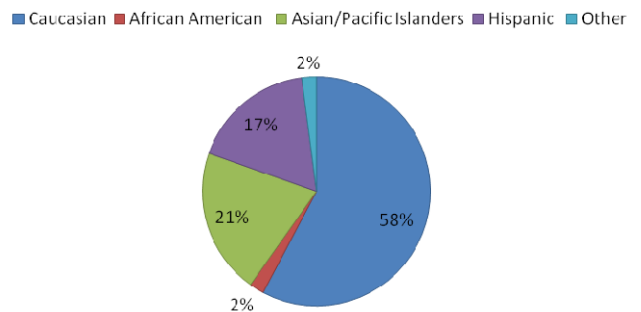


- **2009-2010 Tuition Fees (42 Credit/Units):** \$550/unit
- **Financial Aid:** Available to students based on need and provided in compliance with the Department of Education Financial Aid rules and regulations.

Student Demographics MPH & DO/MPH

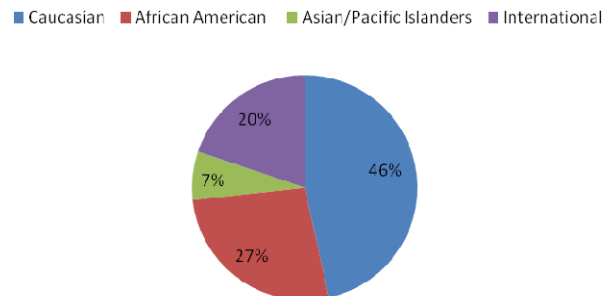


Student Demographics Joint Program



- **GPA's for Entering Classes (DO/MPH and MPH):** 2007: 3.16; 2008: 3.2; 2009: 3.23
- **GPA's for Entering Classes (Joint Program):** Classes 2010: 3.1; 2011: 3.2; 2012: 3.14
- **Faculty:** The Program is supported by 13 full-time faculty and 4 adjunct faculty. The student-to-faculty (FTE) ratio is 7.69:1.
- **Public Health Field Study Sites:** 30 sites for Community Health Track students located in the San Francisco Bay Area, Central & Southern California, and Arizona; and two sites for Global Health Track students, one located in Jimma, Ethiopia and the other in La Paz, Bolivia.
