This process requires a complete training for all staff. including 18-hours for nursing staff and 3- hours for all medical staff. There are opportunities within the scope of this type of training for study, class preparation, and data collection/analysis. Another project that could enrich a student experience is our Veggie Box Program. This program involves providing fresh, local fruits and vegetables to our patient and employee population to reduce risk factors for diabetes and obesity. Opportunities for a student in this program include data collection, outreach, community support, and program coordination. Finally, we are starting to work on a small adolescent program in our pediatric clinic that includes FPACT-services (such as pregnancy prevention, STD screening, etc) and does some nutrition/obesity prevention.
